(The use of plain yellow paper is recommended)

- To facilitate the distribution of the Peoples' International, you can print the leaflet on pages 3 and 4. Print it recto-verso with the short side facing down, then divide it in two, making two leaflets to distribute at demonstrations. At the top right of the leaflet is a QR Code which takes you to the website where the video is broadcast.
- To publicise the Peoples' International, you can also print self-adhesive labels, the matrix of which is shown on page 2, with the following production instructions.


Print page 2 of this file on yellow paper in a reprographics shop. As the quantity of toner required is relatively large, there will be no extra cost - the price is charged by the page.

Next, cut out the yellow border at the top of the sheet (1) and stick a 48mm wide self-adhesive strip along the black border on the reverse (DIY shops charge around 5 euros for 25m) (2).

Carefully cut out this first row of two stickers (3).

Then cut off the two ends and separate each sticker by cutting down the middle, and repeat the operation (4).

A word of advice: for each label, pre-cut the sticker on one corner. This tedious work is necessary to make it easier to stick when you're near a well-placed, clearly visible support. (This avoids having to spend a minute trying to separate the face of the sticker from the label in front of a well-placed surface) (5, 6 and 7) NOT LETTING GO!
